



Covid-19 Policy (as of March 27, 2024)

Rehearsal Process

Exposure

- Artists are expected to wear a mask and monitor their symptoms if they have been exposed to someone with Covid-19. If symptoms worsen, stay home until they improve and wear a mask when returning to rehearsal until symptoms are gone.

Testing positive

- If an artist tests positive for Covid-19, they are expected to isolate until their symptoms begin to improve, then return to rehearsal masked until their symptoms are gone. If they are asymptomatic they are expected to stay masked for ten days.

Masking

- Wearing a mask is optional during rehearsals for artists not experiencing symptoms of Covid-19 or other illnesses. The only period during which Gather would ask symptom-free actors to stop wearing a mask is when onstage during dress rehearsals and performances.
- Wearing a mask during rehearsal is also expected when any artist involved is experiencing illness *not* related to Covid-19 so as to decrease the chances of spreading any form of sickness to others in the room.

Performances

At Gather Repertory performances, wearing a mask is optional but strongly encouraged for the protection of the audience as well as the actors. We do not currently require vaccinations or a negative test for entry. Please note that in the event Covid-19 infection levels rise in Yamhill County, this policy is subject to change.
